### CULINARY ARTS EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

In this department we have Youth: age 5 – 12, Teen: age 13 – 18 and Adult: age 19 +. **Be sure to indicate the correct age group on your entry form.** If exhibitor is less than 18 years of age, include your age and your parent signature where indicated. Failure to comply with these rules may result in entry disqualification of the entry.

**\* The Culinary Arts Department and the Maricopa County Fair are *not* responsible for entries remaining after Sunday, April 18, 8:00 pm.**

Read instructions carefully:

1. Exhibitors **cannot** be Professional
2. One entry/item - per Class - per exhibitor (not including Special Competitions)
3. Entries must have been prepared after the 2009 Maricopa County Fair.
4. Exhibitor is responsible for determining proper Division and Class of entry.
5. Product labels must be securely attached to the back of the entry form.
6. The Culinary Arts Department reserves the right to remove *and* dispose of foods showing signs of spoilage.
7. Displaying exhibits:
  - Entries must be inserted into a clear plastic bag and sealed with a ziplock or twist - ties. Attach entry tag to the plate or pan.
  - Candies / Cookies: exhibited on a sturdy disposable plate.
  - Six candies per plate
  - Six cookies per plate (cookie dia. up to 3")
  - Half - Cakes, plus one slice, *only* will be accepted. Include extra slice with cake entry on a sturdy disposable plate.
  - Pies exhibited in a sturdy disposable pan.
  - Breads / rolls exhibited on a sturdy disposable plate. Enter whole loaves of bread. No mini loaves accepted.
8. Containers:
  - a Canned good entries: submit two jars - one for judging and one for display.

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- b Jars: standard canning jars identified by the manufacturer name on the container.
- c *Do Not* use half - gallon jars or mayonnaise jars.
- d Use caps and seals free from rust or scratches ~ preferably new
- e Screw rim must be loosened but not removed.
- f Seal must be tight and intact when opened for judging.
- g Jellies: in standard jelly glasses or standard half - pints with lids. Do not use wax.
- h Preserves, jams, conserves, pickles and relishes: exhibited in pints.
- i Dill pickles are accepted in quart jars.
- j Canned products - meat - fruit - vegetables: exhibited in pint or quart canning jars.
- k Canned goods must be clearly labeled and free from stickiness.
- l Labels: placed on the bottom of each jar, should show date made and name of product. *Do not include exhibitor name on labels.*
- m **Items not labeled will not be accepted.**
