RABBIT EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

1. Exhibitor must own and be raising rabbit on or before March 1, 2010. No exceptions.
2. Pedigree papers must be turned in at receiving. Pedigrees are not required for Backyard Bunnies.
3. Entries must have a legible, clearly defined tattoo ~ in the left ear. Excess ink *MUST* be removed from the ear before receiving.
4. Indicate breed and age of rabbit ~ ex: Mini Rex, Holland Lop, Flemish Giant, and ex: Jr. or Sr. Do not use birth date or indicate age by months and years. If you are uncertain about the age of your animal, contact your leader - advisor - or the Department Superintendent.
5. Rabbits with evidence of parasites or contagious disease will be disqualified and returned to owner for removal from building or quarantined. Unruly, mean and biting animals will not be accepted.
6. Breeding animals at the fairgrounds is prohibited. A doe that has babies at the fair will forfeit wins.
7. Feeding and watering cans will be provided by the Maricopa County Fair. The Department Superintendent and assistants will feed animals.
8. Maricopa County Fair is not responsible for any loss or damage to animals, equipment, etc. that might occur. Entries are made and accepted on this condition.
9. The fair is not responsible for animals left after specified release times.
10. Rabbit cannot be removed from cages without permission from the Department Superintendent. Notify Superintendent for showmanship. Double divided cages will be used.
11. Exhibitors do not place anything in rabbit cages without permission from the Superintendent. Violation can result in disqualification.
12. **Do Not attach "for sale" cards to cages.**
13. Exhibits for fryer, baker, and roaster will be entered in regular division.
14. Maricopa County Dress Code required. Refer to *Livestock Rules - #25*

Complete entries include entry form, breed, age (Junior or Senior), sex and variety (color), and entry fee. Entry forms not complete with age and sex will be returned as ineligible. *If an entry is received incomplete, the fair office will return the entry to the exhibitor. The entry will be accepted if completed and received in the fair office ALONG WITH A \$25 PROCESSING FEE within 10 days of request. If not received with the processing fee or received after the 10 days, the entry will not be accepted.* All entries must be received in the office no later than March 13. 259	A Backyard Bunny is any rabbit, <i>without aedigree</i> , exhibiting the characteristics of a recognizable individual breed.

DIVISION 3748: Meat Pen

It takes approximately 8 weeks to raise a Meat Pen. Entries can not be more than ten weeks old. All three rabbits should look as much alike as possible. General disqualifications apply in this class. Rabbits must have a permanent tattoo mark. Tattoo must be recorded on the entry form.

Class	Description
260	Breeds maturing - less than 8 lbs: three live rabbits per pen - any sex - uniform in size. Top weight for each rabbit is 4 lbs.
261	Breeds maturing - more than 8 lbs: three rabbits per pen - any sex - uniform in size weighing 3.01 lbs - 5 lbs. Top weight for each rabbit is 5 lbs.

Class	Description
262	Maximum age 10 weeks ~ maximum weight 5 lbs.

DIVISION 3750: Baker

Class	Description
263	Less than 6 mo. old: Minimum weight 5.5 lbs. ~ maximum weight 8 lbs.

Class	Description
264	More than 6 mo. Old: Minimum weight 8 lbs.
