In this department we have Youth: age 5 – 12, Teen: age 13 - 18 and Adult: age 19 +. **Be sure to indicate the correct age group on the entry form.** If exhibitor is less than 18 years of age, include your age and your parent signature where indicated. Failure to comply with these rules may result in entry disqualification of the entry.

1. Entry must be listed in the Exhibitor Handbook
2. One item/entry - per Class - per exhibitor
3. Entry created by exhibitor
4. Pin name on paper inside garment.
5. Judges will turn garments inside out to check seams and for loose threads. **Please iron garment.**

7. Entries stained or unsanitary will not be accepted.
8. Exhibits consisting of one or more pieces must be mounted or securely fastened together. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.

HAND SPUN YARN

One entry - per Class - per spinner. Contestant should spin skein of yarn after April 2009. Each skein should be 100% plant fiber or 100% animal fiber - 2oz. weight.

Judging guidelines:

1. Purpose of your knitting: weaving (weft or warp), etc. Be specific.
2. Preparation of fiber: cleanliness and even color distribution.
3. Consistency of twist: size and strength
4. Hand and Finish: correct skeining and feel of yarn
5. Important ~ not all yarns to spun smooth and even.
