ENTRIES: All entry forms must be received in the Fair Office no later than March 9, 2012. Make checks payable to Maricopa County Fair.

HANDCRAFT EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

In this department we have Youth: age 5 – 12, Teen: age 13 – 18 and Adult: age 19 +. **Be sure to indicate the correct division number on your entry form.** If exhibitor is less than 18 years of age, include your age and your parent signature where indicated. Failure to comply with these rules may result in entry disqualification of the entry.

Read instructions carefully:

1. Can enter - 1 item - per Class - per exhibitor.
2. Do not enter items/exhibits used in prior Maricopa County Fairs.
3. Entry created by the exhibitor.
4. Entries, without sponsorship of a school, must use a separate entry form.
5. Children in the same family should work on individual projects. Individual family members use separate entry forms. Every entry form must have a parent or guardian signature.
6. The Superintendent reserves the right to combine or divide Classes, depending on entries.
7. Misclassified entries will be redesignated at the discretion of the Superintendent.
8. Items offensive to the general public will not be accepted.

9. Premiums will be mailed, to the address on the entry form, after the Fair.
