JUDGING: Monday, April 9th, 2012, following receiving.

AWARDS: Each project will be judged using the American System. Judges will award blue, red and white ribbons. Rosettes for each class winner if deserving - determined by the judge. Each division winner will receive a plaque.

SPECIAL AWARDS:

- Best FFA Chapter: Awarded to the chapters with the most points. Blue = 6 pts./Red = 3 pts. /White = 1 pt.
 - First place - plaque
 - Second place - plaque
 - Third place - plaque
- Best of Show will receive a rosette and a belt buckle

FFA AGRICULTURAL MECHANICS EXHIBITORS:

- Active Maricopa County FFA members must make projects during the current fair year. A number of common skills must have been applied to construct a useful labor-saving item appropriate for the farm, home,

or to the student or group of students instrumental in its construction.

- Please Note: Do Not Enter as a School, all entries must list Exhibitor Names and contact information.**
- Exhibitors will have the option to sell their projects, at the Silent Auction, while on display during the Maricopa County Fair. If you choose to sell your project in the Silent Auction, please mark your entry form accordingly. Also include the total cost invested into your project.** If you do not mark your form appropriately you will be ineligible for the Silent Auction. Any questions concerning the Silent Auction contact the department Superintendent.
- Exhibitor cannot enter more than 2 exhibits per class.**
- The Silent Auction will open Wednesday, April 11, 2012 and close on Saturday, April 14, 2012, at 6:00 pm.** At that time, the bid sheets will be collected and full payment must be made to the department Superintendent. There will be a 6% commission deducted from the purchase price of each project. Exhibitor checks will be mailed to the FFA Advisor for disbursement after the fair.

***Sold auctioned items will be released on Saturday, April 14, 2012, at bid closing after receiving payment.**
