#### **EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:**

1. **Form G - for schools, classes, groups.** Teachers, list as many students as possible - forms can be duplicated. Include: School name, student name, division and class number for each entry. Teachers are responsible for placing entry tags on art work. Tags will be provided by the fair on receiving day.

2. **Form M - for individual youth entry.**
  - Students entering without a school affiliation
  - Parents may enter their child's exhibit - family members cannot share an entry form
3. No entry limit, assuming space is available.
4. Entries must be created by exhibitor after the 2011 Fair.
5. Models and/or kits are not accepted.
6. Mount artwork onto construction paper or poster board with 1" border or less. Entries may be stapled or tabed for exhibit. Matting is not necessary.
7. Optional: Protect pastels, charcoal, oil pastels, watercolor entries with spray sealant, plastic Mylar sheet or plastic wrap - No Glass.

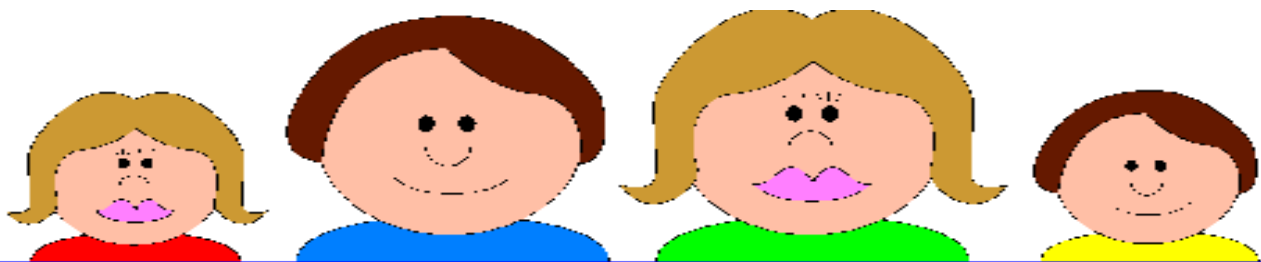
